Meeting Basic Needs

In Fruit Valley:

- 52% of families with children live in poverty
- 81% of students meet income requirements for lunch assistance
- Families struggle for balance where the average income is less than \$25,000 per year per household!

In March of 2010 alone the Fruit Valley Family Resource Liaison handled over 432 requests from needy families.
